The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus and for appointment of a Warrant Officer, with a roving writ to search for the detainee mentioned in para 2 of the petition at the premises of respondents No.2 and 3 or at any other place to be pointed out by the petitioner at the spot, and get the detainee released with their belongings from the illegal custody of the respondents forthwith.

Learned State Counsel has filed reply in response to the notice, in which it is stated that the alleged detainee was never picked up or arrested by the Police. It is also asserted that the alleged detainee is not required by the Police in connection with any case at present. Still further, it is submitted that neither the alleged detainee has been in their custody at any earlier point of time nor is he presently in their custody.

In view of the above, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
