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**GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)**

Petitioner – Mohammed Khalil, stated to be aged 54 years has filed the present writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India *inter alia* with a prayer to direct the respondent No.4 to decide Legal Notice dated 15.03.2019 (Annexure P-11) and to comply with the order dated 11.01.2019 passed by respondent No.3 (Annexure P-2), issued by respondent No.6.

Records of the case show that on 30.07.2020, notice of motion was issued and the order reads as under:-

*“Notice of motion insofar as respondents No. 1 to 7 are concerned, returnable on 13.08.2020.*

*Mr. Navdeep Chhabra, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, takes notice for respondents No.1 to 7 and waives further notice. He seeks time to get instructions as to the steps taken pursuant to the order dated 11.01.2019 passed by the Director, Rural Development and Panchayats, Punjab.”*

Thereafter, the case was again adjourned on 13.08.2020 for today  
i.e. 28.09.2020.

Learned State counsel, submits that the FIR has been registered  
against respondent No.8.

Learned counsel for the petitioner also submits that he has  
instructions to the same effect.

In view of the above, since the substantial relief has already been  
granted to the petitioner, no further orders are called for.

Disposed of accordingly.
