1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, is for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for violating order (Annexure P-1) dated 06.12.2019 in CWP No.35466 of 2019.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that vide order (Annexure P-1) dated 06.12.2019, CWP No.35466 of 2019 was disposed of by directing the Financial Secretary-cum-Principal Secretary, Government of Haryana, Higher Education, to decide legal notice dated 07.06.2019, by passing a speaking order within 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and yesterday, copy of order dated 24.11.2020, passed by the Chief Secretary, Government of Haryana, in compliance of order dated 06.12.2019 in CWP No.35466 of 2019 has been supplied to him

in view of which, the petitioner does not wish to press the contempt petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order dated 24.11.2020, in accordance with law.

5. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is ***dismissed as withdrawn*** with the liberty, as prayed for.
