The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.114 dated 08.06.2020 registered under Section 22 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Sadar, Nabha, District Patiala.

On 29.07.2020, following order was passed by this Court:-

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been nominated in the disclosure statement of Gurmeet Singh. Petitioner is a licenced chemist and his licence is valid up to 31.12.2022.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of Court, Mr.Rana Harjadeep, DAG,

unjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 2.8.2020 at 11.00 a.m. and in the event of his arrest, he shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, subject to his furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

List again on 8.9.2020.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in compliance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jasbir Singh admitted the aforesaid fact and submitted that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation of the case.

In view of above, interim order dated 29.07.2020 is made absolute. Petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
