Hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

On 29.07.2020, the following order was passed:-

“The petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in a criminal case arising from FIR NO.70, dated 15.04.2019, registered under Section 380/454/447/511 IPC at Police Station Jagraon, District Ludhiana.

As per the case of the prosecution, the first informant is owner of the property and the petitioner along with her husband had tried to take forcible possession thereof by breaking open the iron gate.

Hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is recorded as the owner of the said property in the revenue record and she is sought to be forcibly implicated because she wanted to construct the building after sanction of the building plan. He further draws attention of the Court to the order dated 27.09.2019, passed in CRM-M-25865 of 2019, (Jaswinder Singh vs. State of Punjab)

On the request of this court, Mr. Hittan Nehra, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction

of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel appearing for the State, on instructions from ASI Surender Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation, cooperated and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the interim order dated 29.07.2020 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
