Petitioners claim that they have attained majority and married against the wishes of their family members. Apprehending threat to their life and liberty, they have filed the present petition for protection.

Petitioners claim to have submitted a representation (Annexure P-5) dated 27.07.2020, in this regard, to the Superintendent of Police, Sirsa.

Heard. Record perused.

Notice of motion to the office of Advocate General Haryana.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Munish Sharma, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State. Copy already supplied.

Petitioners have placed on record copy of Aadhar Card of petitioner No.1 and Certificate of Secondary Education of petitioner No.2 (Annexures P-1 and P-2) respectively as proof of their age as well as copy of Marriage certificate (Annexure P-3) and photographs (Annexure P-4).

This petition is disposed of with a direction to the Superintendent of Police, Sirsa, to look into the representation Annexure P-5 dated 27.07.2020 and ensure that no harm is caused to the petitioners.

However, it is made clear that this order shall not be treated as stamp of the Court about the marriage of the parties and no opinion regarding the validity of the marriage has been expressed.
