The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing in the light of the pandemic COVID-19 situation and as per instructions.

This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a direction to re-fix the pay of the petitioners in the Pay Scale of 3120-6200 as on 01.01.1996, in terms of judgment dated 03.04.2014, passed in CWP-7005-2001 (Annexure P-2).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Director General of Police, Punjab Police Head Quarter, Sector 9, Chandigarh, to consider and decide the legal notice dated 17.06.2020 (Annexure P-9), expeditiously.

Heard.

Having regard to the prayer made and without adverting to the

merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Director General of Police, Punjab Police Head Quarter, Sector 9, Chandigarh, to consider and decide the legal notice dated 17.06.2020 (Annexure P-9), in terms of the judgment dated 03.04.2014 (Annexure P-2), passed by this Court, within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioners is admissible to them, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed, within a period of six weeks thereafter, in accordance with law. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioners is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
