The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to COVID-19 situation.

2. The petitioners have filed the present petition to protect their life and liberty, apprehending threat from respondents No. 4 to 7. It is pleaded that the petitioners are senior citizen. There is a matrimonial dispute between their son and daughter-in-law. FIR No. 138 under Section 498-A IPC at Police station Morinda District Ropar was got registered on 30.08.2012 by the daughter-in-law against their son. The petitioners have disinherited their son. It is further pleaded that there was a civil litigation between the daughter-in-law and petitioner No.1.

3. Mr. Pawan Sharda, Sr. DAG Punjab, appears for respondents No.1 to 3.

4. For the order being passed today, it is not deemed necessary to issue notice to respondents No. 4 to 7.

5. The petition is disposed of with direction to Superintendent of Police, Rupnagar to decide the representation dated 17.06.2020 (Annexure P-4) expeditiously and take necessary action if so warranted.
