1. This petition has been filed against the order dated 08.05.2020 of the Tribunal declining to grant interim relief to the petitioners.

2. When we pointed out to the learned counsel that the services of the petitioners were already dispensed with on 30.04.2020 and therefore no interim order can be granted, he has fairly accepted this but stated that the petitioners were appointed by following a regular process and at the very least they are entitled to the relief that they can not be replaced by any other contractual employee.

2. In our opinion, this prayer can well be made before the Central Administrative Tribunal and consequently, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to move an application to make this prayer before the Tribunal.

3. Since the main case has been decided, the pending application, if any also stands disposed of.
