Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.61 dated 14.07.2018 for the offences under Sections 406/498-A IPC at Police Station Women Sector 17, Chandigarh.

Learned Addl. Public Prosecutor on instructions from ASI Satish Kumar submits that in pursuance to order dated 01.10.2019, petitioner joined investigation, however, despite repeated opportunities, he failed to cooperate with the investigating agency and the recovery of gold jewellery as also other dowry articles has not yet been effected.

In the circumstances, no ground for anticipatory bail is made out.

Accordingly, present petition stands dismissed.
