AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

In compliance with the order dated 21.01.2020 passed by this Court, learned counsel for the petitioners has produced the ETT Eligibility Certificate which the petitioners have passed on 20.02.2017. The last date for receipt of the applications was 28.08.2016 for appointment to the post of ETT Teacher.

As per the certificate, which has been submitted by the counsel for the petitioners, the examination for the ETT post was held in the month of November, 2016, which is also subsequent to the last date of receipt of the applications.

In the light of the above, the claim of the petitioners cannot be accepted as the petitioners were not eligible for consideration for appointment to the post of ETT Teacher as they had not qualified the ETT

examination prior to the last date of receipt of the application.

In view of the above, the present writ petition stands dismissed.
