The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No. 126 dated 08.08.2019, under Sections 306/304-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Jaito, District Faridkot.

2. The petitioner by now has remained in detention for more than one year since 10.08.2019. Investigation against him has already been completed long ago and the challan has been submitted on 08.11.2019. Charges have been framed thereafter. But thereafter evidence from the prosecution side could not be commenced, obviously on account of the ongoing COVID-19 Pandemic. Co-accused – Jaspreet Kaur @ Jassi and Kirna Kaur have already been granted bail by co-ordinate Bench on 29.05.2020 and 05.06.2020 respectively.

3. As such, the prayer of the petitioner for regular bail is allowed and he is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
