Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 4 to take appropriate legal action against respondent No.6 on the basis of complaint dated 03.07.2020 and grant protection of life and liberty from the hands of respondent No.6 and to release the vehicle from respondent No.6.
