Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to the official respondents not to harass the petitioners by calling them to police station again and again in their family dispute, without complying with the provisions of Section 160 Cr.P.C. and not to implicate the petitioners in a false case at the instance of respondent No.6.

Reply by way of affidavit of Superintendent of Police, Punjab Bureau of Investigation (PBI), Kapurthala, District Kapurthala on behalf of respondent No.4 filed in the Court today, is taken on record. As per this affidavit, respondent No.6 has given a complaint against the petitioners for

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committing the offence of fraud and cheating.

Learned State counsel submits that during inquiry of the said complaint, the petitioners were issued various notices to appear and face the inquiry, however, they are not cooperating. Learned State counsel has referred to summons issued to the petitioners and submits that a legal course is being adopted. It is also submitted that till date, no FIR has been registered and in case the petitioners failed to respond to the notices, further legal action will be taken.

In view of the above, no further action is called for, in the present petition and the same is rendered as infructuous.
