The case is taken up through video conferencing on account of COVID 2019.

By filing this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No. 180 dated 30.10.2019 registered under Section 306 IPC at Police Station City Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur.

Notice of motion was issued to State. Meanwhile, petitioners were granted interim anticipatory bail and directed to join investigation.

On instructions from ASI Nirmal Singh, learned State counsel submitted that petitioners have joined investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of above, petition is allowed. Order dated 30.7.2020 granting interim anticipatory bail to petitioners is made absolute. However petitioners shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so by Investigating Agency and shall abide by conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
