This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.818 dated 24.08.2019, under Section 379-A IPC, registered at Police Station, Chandni Bagh, Panipat, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that as per allegations in the FIR, there are three main accused namely Rahul, Vicky and Mangal and consequent upon their disclosure statements, present petitioner was involved and arrested in this case on 28.12.2019.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rajiv, Police Station Chandni Bagh, Panipat, informs that Rs.1800/- have been recovered from the present petitioner. She further states that the challan has already been presented and out of 13 prosecution witnesses, none has been

examined so far.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further refers to the statement dated 06.02.2020 (Annexure P-2) given by the complainant, whereby she did not identify three main accused.

Heard.

Keeping in view that the petitioner's name was given in the disclosure statement(s) made by three accused persons; period of incarceration of the petitioner and the fact that the trial will take some time for its conclusion, this Court feels that no purpose will be served by detaining the petitioner any longer. Accordingly, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing of bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Panipat.
