Case has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been moved for issuance of directions to respondent No.3 to provide adequate security and safety to petitioner or for issuance of directions to decide representation dated 08.07.2020 (Annexure P/1) moved by the petitioner to respondent No.3.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representation dated 08.07.2020 (Annexure P/1) to respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/1, but still no action has been taken.

Reply on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4-State has been filed, which is taken on record.

On a bare perusal of para No.6 of preliminary submissions in reply, it appears that representation dated 08.07.2020 (Annexure P/1), which has been already addressed to Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar-respondent No.3, has not been responded to or decided by the authorities concerned till date.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, to look into and decide representation dated 08.07.2020 (Annexure P/1) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within four weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
