GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of the restrictions due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioner-Amrik Singh, stated to be aged 27 years, has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer to grant him anticipatory bail in case FIR No.183, dated 25.06.2020, under Section 376 of IPC, registered at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala.

Vide order dated 31.07.2020, the petitioner was granted interim bail and directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Mandeep Kaur states that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. The order dated

31.07.2020 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr. P.C.
