The petitioner, a Junior Basic Training Teacher, is aggrieved by the action of the authorities of the Education Department of the State of Haryana in not transferring her to her home District, in terms of the transfer policy dated 29.06.2016. As her legal notice dated 28.03.2020 failed to evoke any response, she is before this Court.

Mr. Ankur Lal, learned counsel for the petitioner, would state that other teachers, who were similarly situated, approached this Court and pursuant to the orders passed in their cases, their representations were considered favourably.

As it is for the authorities concerned to apply their mind to the petitioner's grievance in the first instance, this Court does not deem it

necessary to keep this case pending for adjudication on merits.

The writ petition is accordingly disposed of directing the respondents herein to consider the petitioner's legal notice dated 28.03.2020 (Annexure P-8) on its own merits and take necessary action thereon. This exercise shall be concluded expeditiously and in any event, not later than two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
