Affidavit of Mr. Rajinder Singh Sohal, PPS, Senior Superintendent of Police Gurdaspur, in compliance of the order dated 26.10.2020 has been filed, whereby it has been mentioned that DDR No.45 dated 28.10.2020 has been submitted in the Court of SDM, Gurdaspur, in the proceedings under Section 107 and 150 Cr.P.C. initiated against respondent No.7 and his brother Tejinder Singh, on account of threatening the petitioner and his family members and servant. It has also been mentioned that possession of the plot has been handed over to the petitioner No.1, as per Annexure R-1/T.

Ms. Paul, appearing for respondent No.5 has also referred to the affidavit of the Executive Engineer of the Punjab State Power Corporation dated 02.11.2020 to submit that as per the condition of the

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connection order, on account of the wrong declaration by respondent No.7, the electricity connection has been duly disconnected on the plot in question.

Faced with this situation, Mr. Mahajan, submits that he does not wish to press the present petition, as the necessary relief has been granted, in view of the earlier orders passed in favour of the petitioner.

Accordingly, no further orders are called for and the writ petition stands disposed off.
