The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 141 dated 30.8.2019, registered under Sections 307, 379B, 323, 506, 427, 341, 148, 149 and 120B IPC; and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station City Khanna, District Ludhiana.

It is contended by the counsel for the petitioner that the case against the petitioner is totally concocted. Even as per the case of the prosecution, no grievous injury has been caused to any person in this alleged incident. Otherwise also, it is a case of version and cross version, in which even certain persons from the side of the petitioner have suffered injuries at the hands of the complainant side. The present FIR has been lodged as a counter blast because the petitioner side had lodged another FIR against the complainant.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Luvinder Sofat, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State and Mr. Pankaj Bali, Advocate, puts in appearance to accept notice on behalf of the complainant.

It is contended by the counsel for the State, being instructed by ASI Sukhwinder Singh and being assisted by the counsel for the complainant, that the petitioner along with his accomplices attempted to kill the complainant. However, it is not disputed that the injury allegedly caused to the complainant is simple in nature.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed. In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds/surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
