Petitioner has approached this Court for grant of regular bail by filing this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, in FIR No.0221, dated 19.10.2019, registered at Women Police Station Panipat, District Panipat, under Sections 313, 376 (D), 376 (2) (n), 406, 498-A & 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

Counsel for the petitioner has referred to the order dated 11.08.2020 passed by this Court, whereby the order indicates that the Court had adjourned the case with an intention that the evidence of the prosecutrix should be complete so that there is no undue influence or pressure of any type on the complainant.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Sudarshan, Women Police Station Panipat, District Panipat, informs the

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Court that the said exercise is over before the trial Court.

In view of the above, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Panipat.

Any observation made herein-above shall have no bearing on the merits of the case during the trial in any manner.
