The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.120 dated 26.07.2018, registered under Sections 302 and 34 IPC (later on Section 34 of IPC deleted and Sections 120-B, 148, 149 IPC added) at Police Station Beri, District Jhajjar.

Initially the FIR was registered against the petitioner and others on suspicion. Thereafter a supplementary statement of the complainant Kulwant Singh was recorded on 30.07.2018,

wherein he has specifically alleged incriminating role qua the petitioner that his son Wazir Singh was murdered by the petitioner Manjit Kaur in connivance with Sukhdev Singh @ Mota, Hardev Singh @ Ganja, Kuldip Singh @ Bohar Singh and two other unknown persons. The prosecution has already examined the complainant Kulwant as PW-1, Dr. Ranjit Singh as PW-2, ASI Surjit Singh as PW-3, SI Rajinder Singh as PW-4 and C. Gurjit Singh as PW-5.

The prosecution witnesses have already supported the case of the prosecution in respect of involvement of the petitioner in commission of offence in connivance with her paramour and others. Out of 13 prosecution witnesses, 5 witnesses have already been examined.

Keeping in view the stage of trial and without forming any final opinion on merits of the case, no indulgence can be granted in the favour of the petitioner for regular bail. The petition is dismissed accordingly.
