The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 CrPC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.130652 dated 28.05.2020 under Sections 406, 420, 370, 120-B, 506 IPC, Sections 10, 24, 25 Emigration Act and Section 12 Passport Act registered at Police Station Jhansa, District Kurukshetra.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has been compromised between the parties and in terms of order dated 30.07.2020, the petitioner has deposited a sum of Rs.25,000/- with the Deputy Commissioner, Kurukshetra. He has produced before this Court receipt No.2301 dated 08.09.2020 of Rs.25,000/- through email, which is taken on record.

Counsel for respondents no.2 and 3 submits that the complainant has no objection in case the petitioner is admitted on bail, as the matter has been compromised.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties and this petition being for grant of anticipatory bail, this Court finds that the interim order dated 30.07.2020 deserved to be made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 30.07.2020 is made absolute.
