Rajiv Sharma, J.

The petitioners are aggrieved by the show cause notices all dated 26.3.2019.

The petitioners are permitted to file replies to the show cause notices issued by the sole respondent within a period of thirty days from today. The respondent shall decide the matter as per the grounds taken in the replies to be filed to the show cause notices. The matter would be decided by the respondent within a further period of four weeks. The petitioners shall also be afforded personal hearing.

The ad-interim order dated 10.5.2019 only reproduced as under:-

“As an interim measure, we permit the petitioners to dispense CNG from the outlets namely i) Ishar Gas Jalandhar Pvt. Ltd., ii) Ishar Gas Ludhiana Pvt. Ltd. and

iii) Ishar Gas Kutch (East) Pvt. Ltd. and respondents may grant them a no objection certificate in this regard but this would purely be an interim measure and the operationalisation would be at the risk and responsibility of the petitioners.” would operate to continue till the matter is decided by the respondent.

In view of the aforesaid observations/ directions, the writ petition stands disposed of.
