The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.62 dated 03.07.2020 registered under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506, 34 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) at Police Station Behrampur, District Gurdaspur.

On 04.08.2020, following order was passed:-

*“Case taken up through video
conferencing.*

Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia

submits that due to a civil dispute pending between the parties the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. He further submits that the injuries attributed to the petitioner are simple in nature and the grievous injuries are attributed to Kamlesh.

Notice of motion.

Mr.J.S.Ghumman, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and prays for time to argue the matter.

Adjourned to 21.09.2020.

In the meanwhile subject to the petitioner's joining investigation as and when called by the investigating agency as also abiding by the other conditions provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C, in the event of his arrest in FIR No.62 dated 03.07.2020 registered under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506 and 34 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) at Police Station Behrampur, District Gurdaspur he shall be released on ad interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sarwan Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required in further investigation of the case.

In view of above, order dated 04.08.2020 is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so by the Investigating Officer and shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
