The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in this petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of directions to police officials i.e. respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner, who is old age person, at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that marriage of daughter of the petitioner Baljeet Kaur was solemnized with respondent No.4-Sandeep Kumar on 14.12.2019. She was given poison by the accused in order to kill her. He further submits that a representation Annexure P-1 dated 26.07.2020 highlighting the aforesaid fact was submitted to the Commissioner of Police, District Amritsar, but no action thereof has been taken on the representation.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. V.G. Jauhar, Senior DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Considering the old age of the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, District Amritsar i.e. respondent No.2 to consider the prayer of the petitioner as regard protection of his life and liberty and to act in accordance with law.
