1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, is for the issuance of a direction to respondent No.2 to grant parole for agriculture purpose to the petitioner for 06 weeks in view of Section 3(1) (c) of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988 by deciding the application (Annexure P-1) dated 28.05.2020.
3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the application for parole (Annexure P-1) dated 28.05.2020 is pending decision, till date and that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the same, in accordance with law, in a time bound manner.
4. Notice of motion.
5. Ms. Tanisha Peshawaria, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice and states that she has no objection to the limited prayer of the petitioner.

6. Without commenting upon the merits of the controversy or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the writ petition is ***disposed of*** by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the application (Annexure P-1) dated 28.05.2020, in accordance with law, after taking into account all aspects of the matter as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of two weeks from today.
