It has been stated by the learned counsel for the petitioners that that the marriage of petitioner No.1 was solemnized with respondent No.4 about 15 years ago and petitioner No.2 was born out from the wedlock. On account of matrimonial dispute, the petitioners have been turned out of the matrimonial house. Even the parental family of petitioner No.1 is not supporting them, she has taken refuge in the house of her friend and a representation dated 20.07.2020 (Annexure P-1) has already been submitted to respondent No.2.
