Instant Petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.125 dated 04.09.2019 registered under Sections 452, 326, 324, 323, 148 and 149 IPC (Section 450 IPC added later on) at Police Station Raja Sansi, Amritsar (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that the injury attributed to the petitioner with kirpan, which he was allegedly carrying at the time of said occurrence, has been opined to be simple in nature. He further contends that the investigation in the present case has been completed and challan has been filed on 13.03.2020. It has also been contended that the petitioner be granted concession of regular bail since the trial is unlikely to conclude in the near future due to outbreak of Covid-19.

Per contra, learned State counsel while opposing the prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner has apprised this Court that the occurrence in question took place while the petitioner was on bail in FIR No.99 dated 15.10.2018 registered under Sections 323, 452 and 506 IPC.

Heard.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, I do not deem it a fit
to extend the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
