The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of lockdown due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioner-Raspreet Singh aged 29 years s/o Balkar Singh, has filed the instant criminal writ petition *inter alia* with a prayer to issue a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus to secure the release of his wife namely Ramanjot Kaur, who has been illegally detained by respondent Nos. 4 and 5.

Records of the case show that in this case, notice of motion was issued on 29.07.2020.

The report has been submitted by the Warrant Officer dated 07.08.2020, stating therein that the girl/detenué has stated that there is no pressure of her family members on her and she is living with her free will and consent at her parents' house.

In view of the above report, no further orders are called for.

The present writ petition is disposed of as having become infructuous.
