1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.435 dated 29.08.2019, registered under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B of IPC, 1860, at Police Station Sector 9-A, Gurugram, Haryana.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 31.07.2020, the petitioners joined investigation and fully cooperated with the police, were released on ad interim pre arrest bail and that their custodial interrogation is not required.
4. Learned Asstt. AG, Haryana, on instructions from *SI Seema*, confirms that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 31.07.2020, the petitioners joined investigation, were released on ad-interim pre-arrest bail and that their custodial interrogation is not required.
5. In view of the statement of learned Asstt. AG, Haryana, order dated 31.07.2020, passed by this Court, is made absolute. The petitioners shall continue to abide by the terms and conditions enumerated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
6. Petition stands disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
