The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Earlier CRM-M No.408 of 2020 was ordered to be dismissed as withdrawn vide order dated 6.2.2020.

Petitioner in second attempt seeks regular bail in case bearing FIR No. 146 dated 17.9.2019 registered at Police Station City-1, Sangrur. Initially the FIR was registered under Sections 308, 323, 506, 34 IPC. Offences under Sections 307, 325, 109, 120-B IPC were added subsequently on the basis of investigation done by the police.

As per allegations in the FIR, the petitioner hit the

complainant with baseball bat on his head. Complainant fell down. Petitioner repeated the blow. When the petitioner tried to hit the complainant on third occasion, a boy, namely, Tehru stopped him from doing that. In the meanwhile, petitioner fled away from the spot after leaving the baseball bat and went to his bua's house. Thereafter, his bua started abusing the complainant party. Petitioner committed the aforesaid act on the asking of Vishal Kumar and Sita.

Due to complicity of the petitioner, this Court was not inclined to grant bail on earlier occasion and faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner withdrew the same on 6.2.2020.

In view of nature of injury and the stage of the trial, I do not incline to grant bail to the petitioner.

This petition is accordingly dismissed.
