The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of lockdown due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioner-Farjana, stated to be aged 35 years, have filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. *Inter alia* with a prayer for issuance of direction to the respondents to conduct fair investigation by some independent agency at State Headquarter level or to transfer investigation out of the District Nuh in a case vide FIR No.468 dated 14.11.2019 under Sections 323, 506 & 34 IPC, registered at Police Station F.P. Jhirka.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, based on the pleadings, submits that although, FIR No.468 dated 14.11.2019, was registered, but, inspite the petitioner's representation being filed from time to time, the

allegations under other Sections are not been considered.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Amit Aggarwal, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

On instructions from ASI Amar Singh, learned State counsel submits that the challan has not yet been presented and the case is at investigation stage.

In view of the above, without commenting upon merits of the case, the present petition is **disposed of** with a direction that in case, the petitioner approaches the police authorities concerned, with above representation (Annexure P-2) or any other representation being filed before the Competent Authority concerned, the same shall be got examined by The Director General of Police, Haryana Police Headquarter, Sector-6, Panchkula (respondent No.2), expeditiously in accordance with law and necessary steps as may be warranted under the facts and circumstances of the case, be taken thereupon forthwith.

A copy of this order be sent to The Director General of Police, Haryana Police Headquarter, Sector-6, Panchkula (respondent No.2), so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.

Disposed of accordingly.
