[2]. Mr. Anmol Malik, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab to accept
notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Let a copy of the Paper-book be
supplied to him.

[3]. It is submitted by Ld. Counsel for the petitioner that no
summons or any other process to secure his attendance before the Ld. Trial
Court had ever been received by him and that the impugned order declaring
him a Proclaimed Offender on 06.01.2011, was never in his knowledge.

[4]. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner further draws attention of the Court to the judgment (Annexure P-3), from which, it transpires that co-accused Mustak has already been acquitted by the Ld. Trial Court in the concerned FIR.

[5]. In the totality of the circumstances and after hearing submissions from both sides, the present petition is disposed off after setting aside the impugned order with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the Ld. Trial Court within a fortnight from date and to apply for fresh bail in accordance with law.

[6]. Ld. Trial Court is directed to pass an appropriate order on his bail application expeditiously thereafter.
