The case is taken up through video conferencing on account of COVID 2019.

By filing this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., petitioners have sought anticipatory bail in FIR No. 129 dated 30.6.2020 registered under Sections 323, 341, 506, 379, 148, 149 IPC (Section 307 IPC added later on) at Police Station Division No. 2, Pathankot.

Notice of motion was issued to State. Meanwhile, petitioners were granted interim anticipatory bail and directed to join investigation, vide order dated 3.9.2020.

On instructions from ASI Balbir Singh, learned State counsel submitted that petitioners have joined investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of above, petition is allowed. Order dated 3.9.2020 granting interim anticipatory bail to petitioners is made absolute. However petitioners shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so by Investigating Agency and shall abide by conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
