B.S. Walia, J. (VC)

1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for the issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to pay the salary for the vacation period in the respondent college in terms of the order passed by this Court in CWP No.16954 of 2015 in case titled as Anurag Chahal and others vs. State of Haryana and others, besides grant them the minimum pay scales admissible to the regular employees for the post of Lab Attendants as also to direct the respondents to allow the petitioners to continue in service and work on their posts till regular selection are made by the respondents.
3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of by granting liberty to the petitioners to submit comprehensive representation to respondent No.2 and a direction being issued to respondent No.2 to

consider and decide the same in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

4. Notice of motion.

5. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Palika Monga, AAG, Haryana, Advocate, who is present, accepts notice on behalf of the State and states that she has no objection to the limited prayer of learned counsel for the petitioners.

6. Without commenting upon the merits of the controversy or the entitlement of the petitioners to the relief claimed, the writ petition is disposed of by granting liberty to the petitioners to submit representation to respondent No.2 within a period of one week from today. In case any representation is submitted by the petitioners to respondent No.2 within the stipulated period of time, respondent No.2 shall consider and decide the same in accordance with law after taking into account all aspects of the matter including the judgments relied upon, in case the same are applicable, preferably within a period of eight weeks thereafter.
