The present petition is filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.98 dated 31.07.2013 under Sections 420/406 of IPC, registered at Police Station Balachaur, District S.B.S. Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner while praying for anticipatory bail submitted that no doubt the petitioner was declared proclaimed offender but that was because he was not aware of the case as he was appearing in another case of similar nature.

Heard.

Even if, the argument that the petitioner was not aware of the pending case and therefore, he could neither join the investigation nor appear before the Court is accepted, even then, it is not a case of anticipatory bail. The allegations in the present case is of taking money in order to send the complainant Abroad. A person appearing as fake travel

agent in order to cheat people by making false promises to settle them
Abroad do not deserves the concession of anticipatory bail and custodial
interrogation is necessary to unearth the involvement of others who are
involved in this organized illegal activity of cheating innocent people by
making false promises.

Dismissed accordingly.
