The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.105 dated 14.03.2020 registered under Sections 420/120B IPC at Police Station Kanina, District Mohindergarh.

Notice of motion was issued on the premise that neither any children nor any other relative of the petitioner is appearing in the examination and, therefore, the allegation that petitioner was instrumental in getting the paper leaked is false. Vide order dated 31.07.2020 arrest of the petitioner was stayed. However, vide order dated 03.09.2020 interim directions were issued for joining of the investigation by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in compliance of the aforesaid order dated 03.09.2020, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurpal Singh admitted the aforesaid fact and submitted that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation of the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 03.09.2020 is made absolute. Petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
