GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of lockdown due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioners-Rajvinder Kaur and Gurmit Singh, stated to be aged 25 & 33 years respectively, have jointly filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of private respondents i.e. Respondents No.4 to 8 and not to interfere in their married life.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that in this regard, a detailed representation dated 28.07.2020 (Annexure P-5) was submitted to the SSP Federal Government Office, in Kurukshetra, Sector-13, Kurukshetra, Haryana 136118 (respondent No.2) and SHO of Police Station K.A.K., Barham Sarobar, Kurukshetra, Haryana (shokuk-hry@nic.in) (respondent No.3).

While refraining from making any expression as regards the veracity of the averments made in the petition, the petition is **disposed of** with a direction that in case, the petitioners approach the police authorities concerned, with above representation (Annexure P-5) with regard to their alleged threat perception, the same shall be got examined by the SSP Federal Government Office, in Kurukshetra, Sector-13, Kurukshetra, Haryana 136118 (respondent No.2) and SHO of Police Station K.A.K., Barham Sarobar, Kurukshetra, Haryana (shokuk-hry@nic.in) (respondent No.3), expeditiously in accordance with law and necessary steps as may be warranted under the facts and circumstances of the case, be taken thereupon forthwith.

A copy of this order be sent to the SSP Federal Government Office, in Kurukshetra, Sector-13, Kurukshetra, Haryana 136118 (respondent No.2) and SHO of Police Station K.A.K., Barham Sarobar, Kurukshetra, Haryana (shokuk-hry@nic.in) (respondent No.3), so as to enable them to do the needful expeditiously.

Needless to say that the aforesaid order shall not be construed to be an expression as regards the validity of the alleged marriage of the parties.

Criminal Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly.
