The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in the present criminal writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondent Nos.4 to 8.

Paper book reveals that the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 29.07.2020 addressed to the Superintendent of Police, Nuh (Mewat) and the present petition has been filed on 29.07.2020 itself. However, at this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is a typographical error in the representation (Annexure P-1) and instead of 27.07.2020, it has been typed as 29.07.2020. Even if it is assumed that representation was submitted by the petitioner on 27.07.2020, this Court finds that the petitioner has rushed to this Court without giving some reasonable time to the authorities, so as to consider the case of the petitioner

as submitted in the representation.

Accordingly, this Court finds that the representation dated 27.07.2020 must be under active consideration of the authorities concerned.

Therefore, no ground for interference in the matter at this stage is made out.
