Case has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been moved for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family at the hands of respondents No.4 to 8.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representation on 24.07.2020 to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/3, but still no action has been taken and petitioner would be satisfied if representation dated 24.07.2020 (Annexure P/3) is ordered to be disposed of in a time bound manner.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala, to look into and decide representation dated 24.07.2020 (Annexure P/3) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within six weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
