CM No. 7845-CWP of 2020 has been filed by the Food Corporation of India ('FCI') seeking disposal of the main writ petition in terms of the order dated 10th August, 2020 passed by this Court in CWP No. 11153 of 2020 (*Dharam Pal v. 6. The present writ petition and the application (CM-7845-CWP of 2020) are disposed of with a direction to the FCI to treat the main writ petition as

representation by the Petitioner and to decide it in accordance with law by a reasoned order, not later than 31st August, 2020, and to communicate such order to the Petitioner, not later than 2nd September, 2020.

7. It will be open to the Petitioner, if aggrieved by such order, to seek appropriate remedies in accordance with law.
