Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of directions to official respondent Nos.1 to 3 to take appropriate legal action against respondent Nos.4 to 8 and further direction be issued to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to decide the representations dated 11.06.2020 and 03.07.2020.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed that the civil Court has granted injunction in favour of the petitioners and in a petition for grant of blanket bail, three days advance notice has been ordered by learned Sessions Judge, Ferozepure, in case the petitioner is required in a criminal case.

In view of the above, as the petitioner is already before the appropriate forum, no case is made out for invoking inherent powers under

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Section 482 Cr.P.C.
