1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Learned DAG, Haryana, states that the order, violation of which has been complained in the present contempt petition has been stayed by Hon'ble the Division Bench today in LPA No.487 of 2020 and LPA No.491 of 2020, therefore, the contempt petition has become infructuous and be disposed of as such.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he does not press the contempt petition any further and states that the same may be disposed of, as having become infructuous, with liberty to the petitioner to move a fresh petition, in accordance with law if the circumstances of the case so warrant.
