The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.165 dated 15.06.2020, under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468 and 471 IPC, registered at Police Station City Sunam, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he has tried to impersonate as Chandandeep Singh, who is an NRI and had tried to withdraw the money but no money was withdrawn and no pecuniary advantage was actually obtained by the petitioner. He is in custody for about 03 months and not involved in any other criminal case.

Learned State counsel states that challan is yet to be filed. He is not in a position to controvert the submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner that no pecuniary advantage was actually obtained by the petitioner as the offence was detected in time.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner is in custody for about 03 months, he is not involved in any other case, Covid 19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
