By these petitions the petitioner had prayed for quashing the
auction notice dated 06.07.2020 (Annexure P-4) for selling the secured
assets of the petitioner.

On 06.08.2020 the following order was passed :-

*“In both the cases counsel for the petitioner states that
a total amount of Rs.5.50 lakhs is due and the petitioner
(who is an agriculturist) is ready to deposit a sum of Rs.2.50
lakhs within a period of 15 days and will ensure that the
remaining amount is deposited timely.*

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Chetan Dayal, Advocate for Ms. Madhu Dayal, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and seeks time to file reply.

Adjourned to 24.08.2020. Till then auction be not finalized.

A photocopy of this order be placed on the files of other connected case(s).

3 Today learned counsel are agreed that the petitioner had deposited a sum of Rs.2.50 lakhs within the time period granted by this Court. The further contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that even the interest has been wrongly charged.

4 Today Mr. Chetan Dayal, Advocate for Ms. Madhu Dayal, Advocate who is appearing on behalf of the respondents has made a very fair offer. He has stated that the petitioner can appear before respondent No.2 and raise his grievance regarding the rate of interest and the respondent No.2 will consider the same and thereafter decide it.

5 Counsel for the petitioner agreed to the offer and states that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent No.2 on 01.09.2020, who shall consider the grievance of the petitioner and pass a written order thereon by 08.09.2020.

6 Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner shall pay the entire outstanding amount on or before 31.10.2020.

7 Counsel for the respondent has very fairly accepted this offer.

8 Both the petitions stand disposed of with the above terms.

9 Since the main cases have been decided, the pending Civil
Misc. Applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
