The present petition is filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case DDR No.31 dated 26.09.2019 attached with FIR No.142 dated 19.07.2018 under Sections 307/323/148/149 of IPC, registered at Police Station, City Sunam, District Sangrur.

It is contended that one of the co-accused Sandeep Singh had got registered DDR, which shows that there was a cross case between the parties. In fact, he had received injuries at the hands of the complainant side. The said DDR is dated 26.09.2019 and therefore, the present petitioners have been falsely enroped and the said DDR has been rather converted into an FIR against the petitioners.

The fact remains that there are specific and serious allegations against the petitioners. The petitioner-Balbir Singh gave kirpan blow on the rib of Sandeep Singh, whereas, petitioner No.2 Jatinder Singh @ Ganeshi accompanied with another co-accused dragged Sandeep Singh and inflicted

injuries upon him. It is a case of collective violence where all the accused have participated in a pre-determined manner and attacked complainant Sandeep Singh.

In view of the same, no ground for anticipatory bail is made out.

Dismissed accordingly.
