1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is for initiating action against the respondent for not complying with judgment, Annexure P/1 dated 13.03.2020 in CWP No.25591 of 2015.
3. Learned Addl. A.G., Haryana states that LPA No.530 of 2020 has been filed in the instant case and is pending adjudication for 03.02.2021.
4. Faced with the aforementioned position, learned Senior Counsel assisted by Sh. Sunil Hooda, Advocate states that in the circumstances, he does not press the contempt petition at this stage and the same may be permitted to be withdrawn by granting liberty to the petitioners to move an application for revival of the contempt petition, if the circumstances of the case, so warrant.

The same is not opposed to by learned State Counsel.

In view of the statement of learned counsel for the parties, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any further orders at this stage while granting liberty to the petitioners to move an application for revival of the contempt petition, if the circumstances of the case, so warrant pursuant to the decision in LPA No.530 of 2020.
