The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.0262 dated 11.12.2018 registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC at Police Station Dugri.

On 05.08.2020, following order was passed:-

“The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is a bank employee.

The wife of the complainant namely Jaspal Kaur

was instrumental in committing the forgery in the account in respect of signatures of the complainant and withdrew the amount under six policies of the complainant. Subsequently, she entered into a compromise with her husband resulting in filing of a criminal miscellaneous for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise. Learned counsel further submits that cruel attempt has been made by the main accused and the complainant to swallow the amount under six policies and harass the bank employees.

Notice of motion for 06.09.2020.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Rana Harjasdeep, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 09.08.2020 at 11.00 a.m. and in the event of his arrest, he shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, on his furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Rajandeep Singh states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required in further investigation of the case.

In view of above, order dated 05.08.2020 is hereby made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so by the Investigating Officer.
